PARKING ON A PORTION OF DODGE STREET

RESOLUTION NO. 3  
for 1996

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that street parking be eliminated on Dodge Street between Williams Street and Bromil Street; and,

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Street parking shall be eliminated on Dodge Street between Williams Street and Bromil Street. Specifically parking shall be eliminated on the north side and portions of the south sides of Dodge Street from Williams Street to Bromil Street.


Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.

This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 14th day of February, 1996.

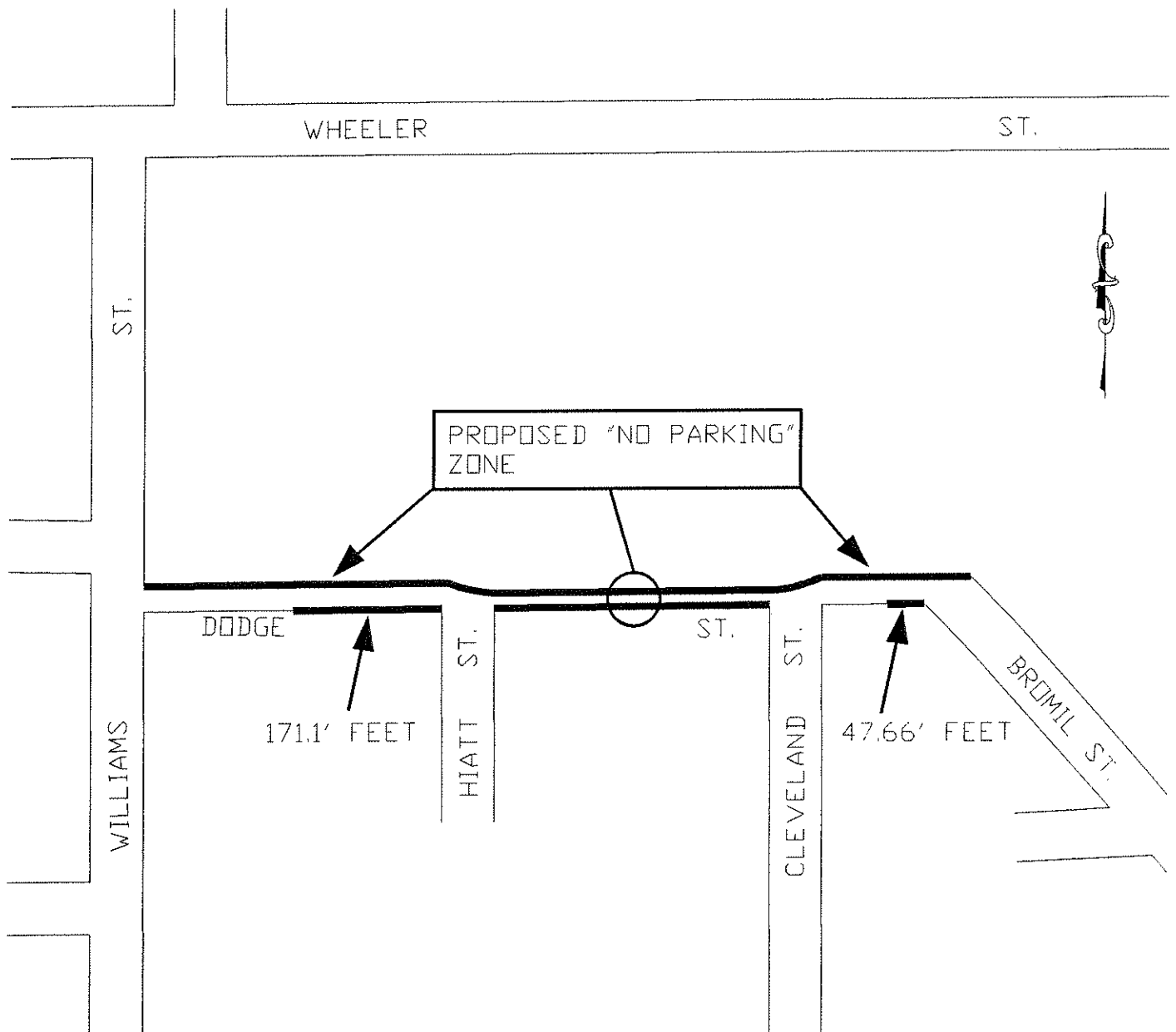
