RESOLUTION NO. 14
for 1998

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be prohibited on a portion of Oak Street near the intersection of Oak Street and Twelfth Street and,

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking shall be prohibited along the south side of Oak Street, beginning at the southeast corner of Oak Street and Twelfth Street then east 243' to the beginning of the "No Park" zone thence east 24' along Oak Street.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.

This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.


Passed by the Council by a vote of 6 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 10th day of June, 1998.
