A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE EFFORTS COMMUNITY SERVICES CONSORTIUM TO CREATE AFFORDABLE HOUSING IN LEBANON

) RESOLUTION NO. 8______) For 1999

WHEREAS, the Lebanon City Council has determined through the adoption of the City's Comprehensive Plan, that the welfare of its citizens requires the availability of a variety of quality housing types and designs at prices citizens can afford; and

WHEREAS, the City's Comprehensive Plan states that: The City should support housing and family assistance programs that would benefit the local community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes that housing prices are rising to the degree that lower income citizens cannot afford the housing available to them and that this burden is especially heavy for lower income single parent families; and

WHEREAS, Community Services Consortium, a public non-profit organization, proposes to build 7 or more units of single family housing located at Cypress Court in Lebanon and plans to target this housing to the needs of low and very low income families;

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Lebanon City Council supports Community Services Consortium's efforts to create affordable single family residences for low and very low income families in Lebanon and urges the US Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, Rural Community Assistance Corporation, and any other funding organizations agree to grant the financial support needed to make this project a success.
