


A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, )  
 LINN COUNTY, OREGON CALLING AN )  
 ELECTION TO SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS ) RESOLUTION NO. 25  
 OF THE CITY THE QUESTION OF ) FOR 1999  
 AUTHORIZING A FIVE YEAR LAW )  
 ENFORCEMENT OPERATING LEVY. )

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon has determined that it is desirable to seek voter approval of a five year local option law enforcement operating levy at a rate of \$0.5662 per \$1000 assessed value for a period of five years commencing July 1, 1999 and ending June 30, 2004.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, LINN COUNTY, OREGON AS FOLLOWS:

1. That an election is hereby called for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the City the question of authorizing a five year local option law enforcement operating levy at a rate of \$0.5662 per \$1000 of assessed value for a period of five years commencing July 1, 1999 and ending June 30, 2004. It is estimated the total amount to be received from such local option levy during the five year period is \$1,246,535.
2. That the election hereby called shall be held on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of September, 1999.
3. That the City directs that there shall be delivered to the election officer of Linn County, Oregon not later than the 61st day before the date of the election the Notice of Measure Election attached hereto, with such changes consistent with the intent of this resolution as are approved by the Mayor and the City Administrator Pro Tem.
4. That the County Clerk shall cause the Notice of Measure Election, sample ballot, polling places and hours the polls are open to be posted and published in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon.
5. Pursuant to ORS 310.145, the five year law enforcement local option operating levy at a rate of \$0.5662 per \$1000 of assessed property value shall be classified as being subject to the limits of section 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution and that the revenues will be used for government purposes other than education, specifically law enforcement purposes.

# NOTICE OF CITY MEASURE ELECTION

City of Lebanon, Oregon

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, September 21, 1999

a measure election will be held in Lebanon, Linn, County, Oregon.

The county clerk has advised us (SELECT ONE):

- The election will be conducted at the polls. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- The election will be conducted by mail.

The following shall be the ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the city's voters on this date:

**CAPTION (10 Words)** Lebanon Five-Year Law Enforcement Local Option Operating Levy

**QUESTION (20 Words)** Shall the City levy \$0.5662 per \$1000 assessed value annually for law enforcement operating purposes? This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent. The proposed local option operating levy is for five years.

**SUMMARY (175 Words)** This measure may be passed only at an election with at least a 50% voter turnout. The purpose of this local option operating levy is to provide law enforcement services. If approved, the measure would authorize a local option rate levy of \$0.5662 per \$1000 of assessed value for five consecutive years commencing July 1, 1999 and ending June 30, 2004. The amount to be collected is estimated to be \$234,791 for the first year, \$241,834 for the second year, \$249,089 for the third year, \$256,562 for the fourth year and \$264,259 for the fifth year. This levy is subject to the limits of Section 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution and will be used exclusively for governmental purposes other than schools, specifically law enforcement purposes.
