**RESOLUTION NO. 51
for 2000**

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon desires to construct and maintain a 54 inch sewer pipeline crossing of property owned by the Union Pacific Railroad Company at Mile Post 685.220 on the Woodburn Springfield Subdivision/Branch at or near Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the City has negotiated an agreement for obtaining a license to construct such pipeline crossing; and


WHEREAS, the City Council hereby determines that such pipeline crossing at the location agreed to is necessary for the health and public welfare for the citizens of the city;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The mayor of the City of Lebanon is hereby authorized to sign and approve the proposed Pipeline Crossing Agreement, identified by the Union Pacific Railroad Company as Folder No. 01861-10.


Section 2. This Resolution repeals any existing Resolutions conflicting with the provisions hereof.
