RESOLUTION NO. 68
for 2000

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be prohibited on a portion of Seventh Street and,

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking shall be prohibited permanently along the west side of Seventh Street from the intersection of 7th and "F" thence south to the intersection of 7th and Airport Rd. Parking shall also be prohibited along the east side of Seventh Street from seven in the morning until three-thirty in the afternoon during the months of September through June, beginning at the intersection of 7th and "F" Street thence south to the intersection of 7th and Airport Rd.


Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.

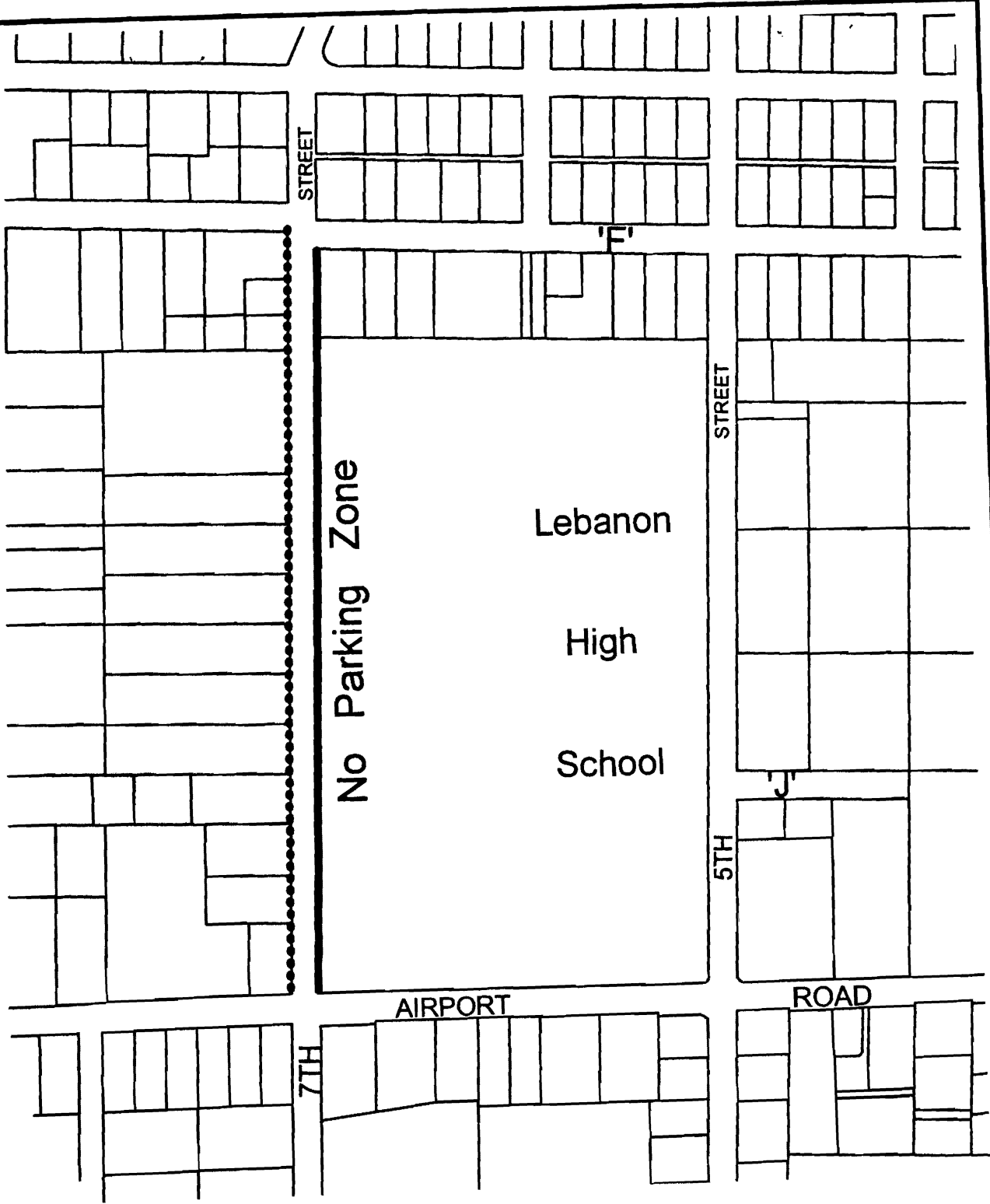
This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.
