WHEREAS, the Lebanon Community School District has indicated its desire to acquire certain real property owned by Mid-Valley Healthcare, Inc., in order to construct a new school; and


WHEREAS, on October 24, 2000, the Board of Directors of Mid-Valley Healthcare, Inc., authorized by resolution a gift of 15 acres to the Lebanon Community School District on property commonly known as the Reeves property and authorized by resolution a gift of additional land to the City of Lebanon necessary to extend 5<sup>th</sup> Street North from the northern border of the gifted school property to Reeves Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Director of Mid-Valley Healthcare, Inc., has resolved to gift this land upon completion of all survey, deed preparation and other appropriate documentation.


