
WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon has adopted Ordinance # 2273 to establish a consistent method of receiving and evaluating claims for compensation under Oregon Measure 7, enacted on November 7, 2000 that amended Article I, Section 18 of the Oregon Constitution; and

WHEREAS, it requires substantial city resources to evaluate any such claims including but not limited to: staff hours, copying, photography, research and the aid of professional experts; and


WHEREAS, in fairness to all the citizens of Lebanon who provide the resources necessary to evaluate said claims;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THE City Council of the City of Lebanon, on this 6th day of December in the year 2000, do hereby authorize and require the payment of a fee of \$750 for the filing of a claim for compensation under Article I, Section 18 of the Oregon Constitution or such other fee as the City Administrator deems appropriate based on the nature, amount and complexity of any alleged claim.
