RESOLUTION NO. 43  
for 2000

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recommended that parking be prohibited on a portion of  
Twelfth Street and,

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement  
of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking shall be prohibited along the west side of Twelfth Street, beginning at the southwest  
corner of Twelfth Street and Airport Road thence south to the terminus of 12th Street of approximately  
550 ' feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be part of the  
traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.

This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing  
parking at this location.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 5 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor  
this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2000.

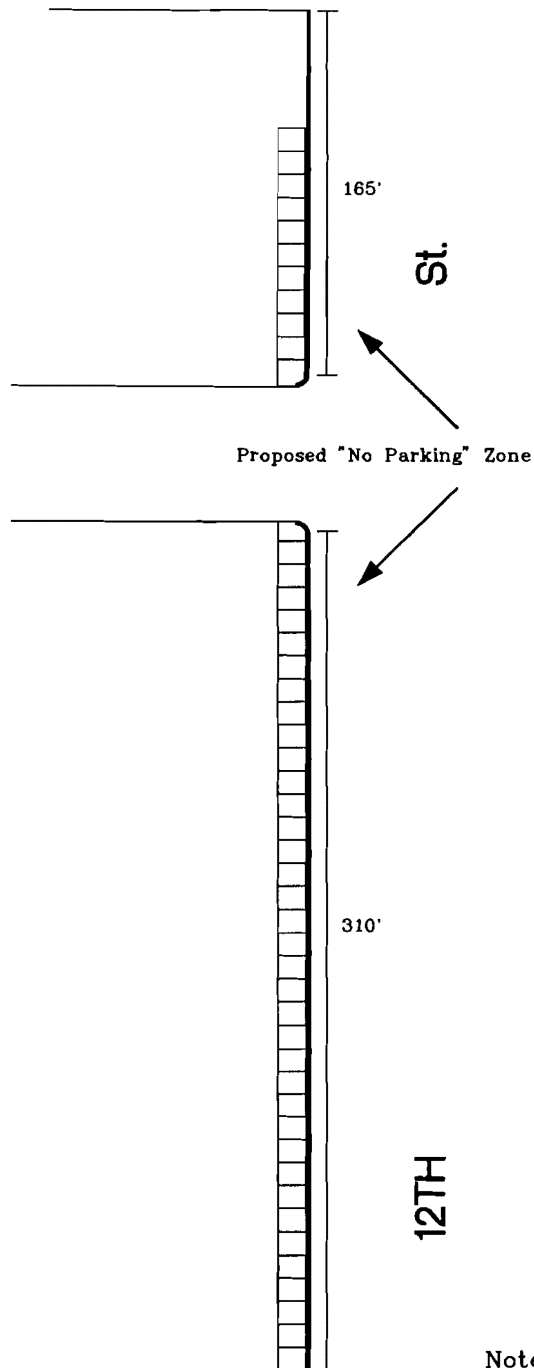
