Section 1. <u>Approval of Intergovernmental Agreement.</u> The intergovernmental agreement with the Agency whereby the City agrees to undertake on behalf of the Agency certain engineering and other services for the conceptual alignment of streets, utilities and other infrastructure within the Area and which are described in the Plan, is approved in substantially the form attached hereto with such changes as are approved by the Mayor and the City Administrator.

Section 2. <u>Execution of Intergovernmental Agreement</u>. The City Administrator is authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement on behalf of the City.
