

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CITY OWNED)
SURPLUS PROPERTY)

RESOLUTION NO. 5
For 2001

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon has owned Tax Lot 900, consisting of 1.86 acres;
and

WHEREAS, Tax Lot 900 is contiguous with Tax Lots 12S 02W 10AD, 3100 and Lots
12S 02W 10AC - 101, 700 and 800, owned by Lebanon Community Schools; and

WHEREAS, all these lots are currently used as a sports field for Lebanon Middle
School; and

WHEREAS, Lebanon Community Schools has declared surplus, and intends to sell,
the referenced lots they own; and


WHEREAS, a new sports field and park will be built at the site of the new Middle
School approximately 1/4 mile to the North; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to retain ownership of 1.22 acres of Lot 900 for public
recreation and open space purposes; and

WHEREAS, the remaining .64 acres no longer is needed for either school or public
recreation purposes.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that .64 acres of Tax Lot 900 is hereby declared
surplus and subject to sale at a fair market price.
