RESOLUTION NO. 10  
for 2003

WHEREAS, the public has requested that parking be prohibited on a portion of West Rose Street and,

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Parking shall be prohibited along the south side of West Rose Street beginning from the intersection of Main Street and West Rose Street thence west to the intersection of Second Street and West Rose Street.

Section 2. Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.


Section 3. This Resolution supersedes and replaces conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective thirty (30) days after its passage by the City Council.

Passed by the Council by a vote of 10 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 23 day of April, 2003.

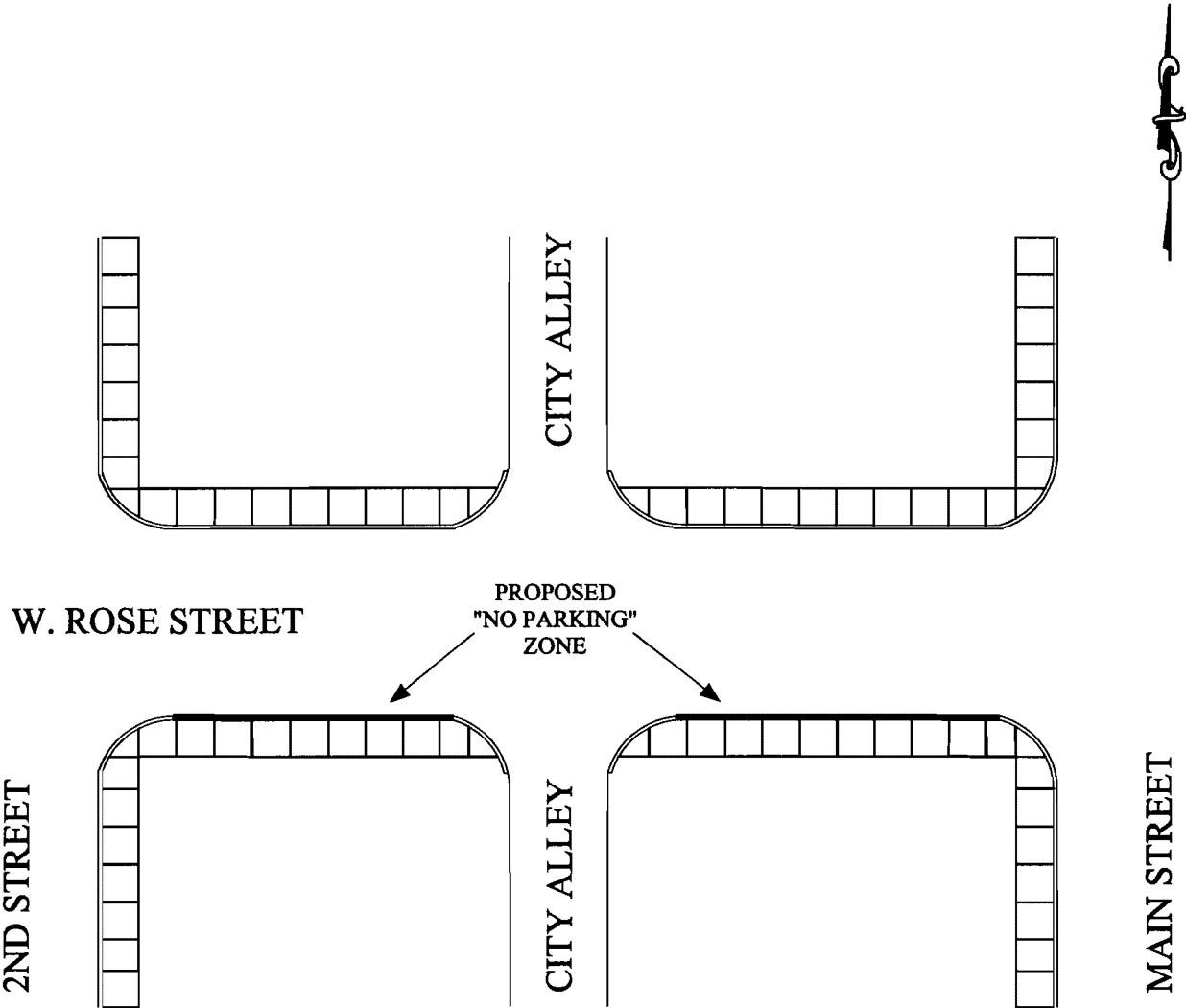
