WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon supports senior activities and helps coordinate senior services; and


WHEREAS, the current Senior Center is inadequate to meet the needs of seniors; and

WHEREAS, the library and cafeteria wing of the former Lebanon Middle School provides a much larger area for a Senior Center than is now currently available.

THEREFORE THE LEBANON CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS: That the Cafeteria/Library wing of the former Lebanon Middle School shall be designated as the Lebanon Senior Center of Academy Square and that it be dedicated to those activities and functions that serve our senior citizens.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City of Lebanon seeks all appropriate means and funds to remodel the new Lebanon Senior Center in order to better facilitate senior programs and activities.


Passed by the Council by a vote of 6 for and 0 against and approved by the Mayor this 11 day of June 2003.
