WHEREAS, the current Lebanon City Charter, adopted in 19980, has some provisions that have been superceded by state law; and

WHEREAS, a new City Charter will better regulate municipal affairs; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to let the voters of the City of Lebanon decide the question of a new City Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Lebanon City Council recommends this proposed Charter of 2004 for consideration by the voters of Lebanon and hereby directs the City Elections Officer to set the date of November 4, 2003 for a public election.

The Lebanon City Council passed this resolution by a vote of 4 for and 0 against on this 13 day of August 2003.
