WHEREAS, the Lebanon Municipal Code, pursuant to the provisions of Section 10.28.030, provides that the City Council may enact resolutions for the purpose of regulating parking lots which are not available for parking to the general public; and

)

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon does own parking lots which are intended to be used for parking to its employees, vendors, or other persons which are not members of the general public; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is necessary and in the best interests of the public that the provisions of Chapter 10.28 of the Lebanon Municipal Code be extended to parking lots owned by the City, but not available for parking by the general public.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LEBANON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Attached to this Resolution, marked as Exhibit "A", and incorporated by this reference are diagrams pf parking lots owned by the City of Lebanon, but which are not available for parking by the general public. All state laws which have been enacted by the city and all city ordinances relating to parking shall be applicable to the parking lots described in said Exhibit "A".
- Section 2. The Lebanon Police Department, and those persons otherwise duly authorized by the Chief of Police or his designate, are hereby authorized to issue parking citations and to otherwise enforce the parking regulations contained in Exhibit "A".
- Section 3. Pursuant to LMC 10.28.020, the maximum penalty for violation of the parking regulations which occur at the parking lots shown in Exhibit "A" which are contained in Lebanon Municipal Code, Title 10, shall be the same as for violations of parking regulations on any public street in the city.
