

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEBANON,) RESOLUTION NO. 26
OREGON AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL)
AGREEMENT WITH THE LEBANON URBAN RENEWAL) for 2007
AGENCY OF THE CITY OF LEBANON)

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, Oregon (the "City") is a "unit of local government" as defined in Oregon Revised Statutes 190.003; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it desirable to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Urban Renewal Agency of the City of Lebanon, Oregon (the "Agency") whereby the City will loan to the Agency current and prior taxes of the Agency estimated to be received for fiscal year 2007-2008; and


WHEREAS, the short term loan will be repaid during fiscal year 2007-2008 with an interest rate that is equal to that rate the City earns on investments, estimated to be five percent per annum.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON RESOLVES:

Section 1. Approval of Intergovernmental Agreement. The intergovernmental agreement with the Agency dated as of the 27th day of June, 2007 whereby the City agrees to loan to the Agency current and prior taxes of the Agency estimated to be received for fiscal year 2007-2008. This short term loan will be repaid during fiscal year 2007-2008 with an interest rate that is equal to that rate the City earns on investments, estimated to be five percent per annum, and is approved in substantially the form attached hereto with such changes as are approved by the Mayor and the City Manager.

Section 2. Execution of Intergovernmental Agreement. The City Manager is authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement on behalf of the City.
