

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEBANON URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON ) RESOLUTION NO. 24 ) ) FOR 2009 )

WHEREAS, the Lebanon Urban Renewal Agency of the City of Lebanon, Oregon (the "Agency") is a "unit of local government" as defined in Oregon Revised Statutes 190.003; and

WHEREAS, the Agency finds it desirable to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Lebanon, Oregon (the "City") whereby the City will loan to the Agency current and prior taxes of the Agency estimated to be received for fiscal year 2009-2010; and

WHEREAS, this short term loan will be repaid during fiscal year 2009-2010 with an interest rate that is equal to that rate the City earns on investments, estimated to be less than three and one-half percent per annum; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has certified, or will certify, tax increment revenues of the Cheadle Lake Urban Renewal Area for collection in fiscal year 2009-2010 in an amount not less than \$193,000 to carry out the purposes of the Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE LEBANON URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON RESOLVES:

Section 1. Approval of Intergovernmental Agreement. The intergovernmental agreement with the City whereby the City agrees to loan on behalf of the Agency certain current and prior taxes of the Agency estimated to be received for fiscal year 2009-2010, is approved in substantially the form attached hereto with such changes as are approved by the Chair and Secretary.

Section 2. Execution of Intergovernmental Agreement. The Mayor or Council President is authorized to execute the intergovernmental agreement on behalf of the Agency.
