WHEREAS, the City Council, after a request from, and a discussion with local neighborhood residents from the segment of "F" Street between 5th and 7th Streets, has recommended that parking be restricted along that street segment between the hours of 8:30 am and 3:00 pm, on days that Lebanon High School is in session, and;

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Parking shall be restricted along that both sides of the street on the segment of "F" Street, between 5th and 7th Streets, during the hours of 8:30 am and 3:00 pm, on days that the Lebanon High School is in session.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be a part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.

This Resolution supersedes and replaces any conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.
