WHEREAS, City Council being duly authorized by the Municipal Code to designate where traffic control devices shall be placed pursuant to LMC Chapter 10.16.060; and

WHEREAS, there has been a significant reduction in the traffic at the intersection of Second and Grant Streets due to the relocation of the Federal Post Office, and a four-way stop is no longer necessary; and

WHEREAS, removal of the stop signs on Second Street is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement and improvement of traffic flow on Second Street in the City of Lebanon (see Exhibit A);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

The traffic control devices (stop signs) shall be removed on Second Street at Grant.

This Resolution supersedes and replaces any conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing signaling at this location.

Passed by the Lebanon City Council by a vote of 6 in favor and 2 against, and approved by the Mayor on this 12th day of August, 2009.




