

A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO DISPENSE WITH ) RESOLUTION NO. 11  
ELECTION FOR ANNEXATION AND FIXING A )  
DAY FOR PUBLIC HEARING ) For 2010

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of ORS 222.120 provide that except as expressly required to do so by a city charter, the legislative body of a city may elect to dispense with submitting the question of a proposed annexation to the electors of the city; and

**WHEREAS**, the city of Lebanon has received a request and application for annexation of real property which meets with the requirements of law; and

**WHEREAS**, the city desires to dispense with an election and proceed with a consideration of the application for annexation pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 222 of the Oregon Revised Statutes.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Lebanon resolves as follows:

**Section 1.** The Lebanon City Charter does not expressly require that a proposal of an annexation to the city be submitted to the electors of the City. Accordingly, the City Council hereby declares its intent to dispense with submitting Annexation proposal Planning File No, 10- 03-17 to the electors of the City and proceed with the consideration of such application as allowed by law.


**Section 2.** The City Council does hereby fix a day for a public hearing before the legislative body on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2010 at 7:00 PM at which time the electors of the city may appear and be heard on the question of annexation of the real property which is the subject of this application.

**Section 3.** A notice of the hearing fixed herein shall be published once each week for two successive weeks prior to the day of the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the city, and notices of the hearing shall be posted in four public places in the city for a like period.

**Section 4.** After the public hearing fixed herein, the City Council shall consider such application and may declare, by city ordinance, that the subject property is annexed to the city as allowed by Oregon law.
