WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Lebanon deems it necessary, expedient and for the best interests of the City of Lebanon to obtain jurisdiction over certain portions of Linn County roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE LEBANON CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The governing body of the City of Lebanon hereby determines that it is necessary, expedient, and for the best interests of the City of Lebanon to accept jurisdiction over certain portions of Linn County roads described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.


Section 2. The Lebanon City Council hereby requests the Board of Commissioners for Linn County the surrender of jurisdiction of said portions of Linn County roads.

EXHIBIT A

Description of Roadway Segments to be Transferred

South Main Road

All that portion of County Road No. 777, South Main Road, as described in Volume 9, Page 62, of the Linn County Road Records lying within the following described property:

That portion of South Main Road, beginning at Vaughn Lane and continuing South to Crowfoot Road, a distance of 1,475 feet more or less.

Weirich Drive

All that portion of County Road No. 717A, Weirich Drive as described in Volume 5, Page 66, of the Linn County Road Records lying within the following described property:

That portion of Weirich Drive, beginning at the Oregon Electric Railroad Northerly Right-of-way, thence East along the centerline of County Road No. 717A, Easterly 1,054 feet.

River Drive

All that portion of County Road No. 719, River Drive, as described in Volume 6, Page 611, of the Linn County Road Records lying within the following described property:

That portion of River Drive, beginning at Franklin Street intersection and continuing East and South to the Southerly bank of the Lebanon-Albany Santiam Canal (including pedestrian bridge).
