WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the 2013 Recreational Trails Program Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed part and recreations, improvements, and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, the Parks Master Plan, and the Lebanon Strategic Trails Plan has identified the need to develop an interconnected trail system; and

WHEREAS, the applicant hereby certifies that the matching share for this application is readily available at this time.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEBANON CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City of Lebanon is authorized to apply for a Recreational Trails Program grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department for the development of trail segments on the islands at Cheadle Lane connecting to the existing Cheadle Lake North Shore Trail and to pave the existing segment of the north shore trail along the north side of Cheadle Lake (see Exhibit A).

Section 2: This resolution is effective immediately upon passage.


Passed by the Lebanon City Council on the 12th day of December, 2012 by a vote of 6 in favor, and 0 against.

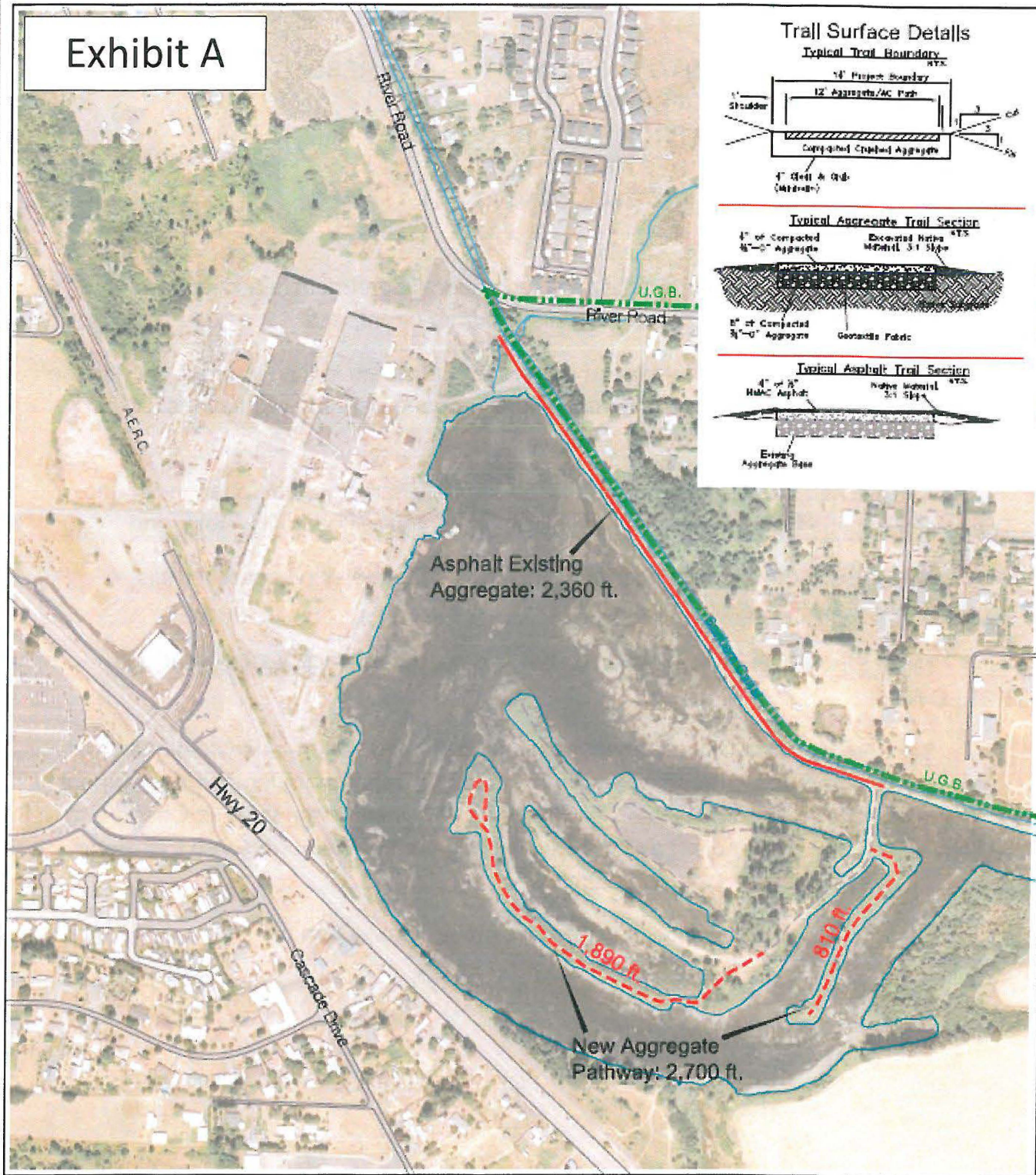
