**WHEREAS**, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Recreational Trails Program Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lebanon desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed parks and recreational improvements and enhancements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council, the Parks Master Plan, and the Lebanon Strategic Trails Plan has identified the need to develop an interconnected trail system; and

**WHEREAS**, the applicant hereby certifies that the matching share for this application is readily available at this time.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE LEBANON CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES:**

**Section 1:** The City of Lebanon is authorized to apply for a Recreational Trails Program grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department for the development of a connector trail (Exhibit A), connecting the existing Mark's Slough Trail and the Mark's Slough Couplet Trail (under construction).

**Section 2:** This resolution is effective immediately upon passage.
