

**A RESOLUTION ALLOWING TEMPORARY ) RESOLUTION NO. 2012-7  
DOWNTOWN SIDEWALK SALES ON THE )  
FIRST THURSDAY DURING THE MONTHS )  
OF JUNE TO OCTOBER, 2012 )**

**WHEREAS**, on the first Thursday for the Months of June to October, 2012. Partners for Progress is sponsoring the "First Thursday Sidewalk Sales" to promote the downtown businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, the downtown business community employs residents, supplies needed goods and services, provides important tax revenue for the City and is an important component in creating a strong, livable community; and

**WHEREAS**, it is important for citizens to recognize the importance and benefits of our downtown businesses and celebrate their role in making Lebanon a better place to live, work and play.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LEBANON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Sidewalk Sales.** Businesses located within the City's Central Business Commercial Zone may display merchandise on the City sidewalks as part of the "First Thursday Sidewalk Sales". These sales may occur without the need of individual temporary use permits.

**Section 2. Dates of Operation.** The sidewalk sales are limited to the following dates: June 7, July 5, August 2, September 6 and October 4, 2012.

**Section 3. Display Conditions.** The outdoor sales displays shall not interfere with pedestrian traffic along the sidewalks, or parking on City streets. A minimum 5-foot walkway along the sidewalk and in front of the business shall be maintained at all times.

**Section 4. Hours of Operation.** Outdoor sales displays shall begin no earlier than 7:00 a.m. and end by 9:00 p.m.

**Section 5. Signs.** Signs placed on sidewalks must conform to requirements in the Lebanon Development Code, Section 16.18.050.A.2.

**Section 6. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become effective upon passage by the Council and approval of the Mayor.

Adopted by the Lebanon City Council and executed by the Mayor on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2012, with 3 Yeas and 0 Nays.
