

**A RESOLUTION RESTRICTING STREET)
PARKING ON A PORTION OF 2nd STREET)
WITHIN THE CITY OF LEBANON)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-12

WHEREAS, City Staff has recommended that parking be restricted on a portion of 2nd Street;

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking shall be restricted along that east side of 2nd Street, beginning at the southeast corner of 2nd and Sherman Street, extending 40 feet south – see attached Exhibit A.

Section 2. Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be a part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.

Section 3. This Resolution supersedes and replaces any conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.

Passed by the Lebanon City Council and executed by the Mayor on this 10th day of April, 2013 by a vote of 6 yeas and 0 nays.
