

**RESOLUTION REGULATING STREET PARKING
ON A PORTION OF S. 5TH STREET WITHIN THE
CITY OF LEBANON**

WHEREAS, the City Council duly authorized by the Municipal Code to designate where traffic control devices shall be placed pursuant to LMC Chapter 10.16.060 and;

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Lebanon as follows:

SECTION 1:

The student pickup and drop of area only shall be along approximately 520 feet of curbing on the West side of Fifth Street. Beginning at the southwest corner of the north parking lot and extending south approximately 520 feet to the northwest corner of the south parking lot as indicated on Exhibit A.


Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be a part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.

SECTION 2:

This Resolution supersedes and replaces any conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.

Passed by the Lebanon City Council and executed by the Mayor on this 9th day of July, 2014 by a vote of 4 yeas and 0 nays.

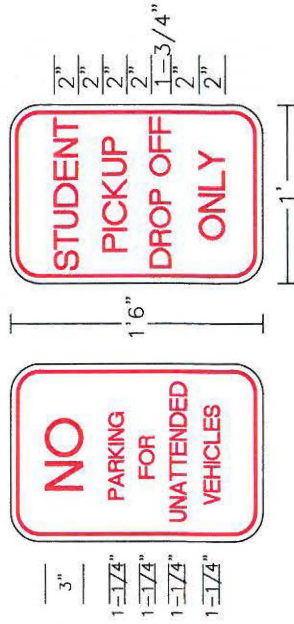
