

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF
LEBANON TO APPLY FOR THE 2014 LAND &
WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT FROM
THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPT
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A RESTROOM &
SHELTER FACILITY AT RIVER PARK**

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-5

WHEREAS, Lebanon's River Park is the largest and most heavily used park in Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, the large shelter which contains the only restrooms at River Park is dilapidated and beyond repair; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the 2014 Land & Water Conservation Fund grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of constructing a new restroom and shelter facility at Lebanon's River Park; and

WHEREAS, the city staff certifies that the matching share for this application is readily available at this time.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEBANON CITY COUNCIL AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: The City of Lebanon is authorized to apply for the 2014 Land & Water Conservation Fund grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department to construct a new restroom and shelter facility at River Park.

Section 2: This resolution is effective immediately upon passage.
