

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING A MORATORIUM)
ON ENFORCEMENT OF ORDINANCE NO. 2855,)
CHAPTER 3.20 OF THE LEBANON MUNICIPAL)
CODE)**

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-32

WHEREAS, Section 134(5) of HB 3400 provides:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, a city or county that adopts an ordinance under this section that prohibits the establishment of an entity described in subsection (1) of this section may not impose a tax or fee on the production, processing or sale of marijuana or any product into which marijuana has been incorporated; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon City Council adopted Ordinance No.2855 on October 22, 2014 which established a tax on the sale of marijuana and marijuana-infused products in the City of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon may choose to adopt an ordinance that prohibits the establishment of marijuana related establishments (as defined in section 134(1) of HB 3400) in the City of Lebanon.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. The City of Lebanon hereby enacts a Moratorium on the enforcement of Ordinance Number 2855, Chapter 3.20 of the Lebanon Municipal Code until further action of the Council.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
