RESOLUTION NO. 2016-4

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the 2016 Recreational Trails Program Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed parks and recreational improvements and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, the Parks Master Plan and the Lebanon Strategic Trails Plan has identified the need to develop an interconnected trail system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon has available local matching funds to fulfill its share of the obligation related to this grant application should the grant funds be awarded; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon will provide adequate funding for ongoing operations and maintenance of this recreation facility should the grant funds be awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. The Lebanon City Council demonstrates its support for the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department to construct a new trail section from Cheadle Lake to the City's parking lot on Mountain River Drive.

Section 2. This Resolution is effective immediately upon its passage.
