**WHEREAS**, Lebanon's Century Park is the second largest and most heavily used park in Lebanon; and

**WHEREAS**, the large shelter which contains the only restrooms at Century Park is dilapidated and beyond repair; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the 2017 Local Government Grant Program Large Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lebanon desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of constructing a new restroom and shelter facility at Lebanon's Century Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the city staff certifies that the matching share for this application is readily available at this time.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

**Section 1.** The City of Lebanon is authorized to apply for the 2017 Local Government Grant Program Large Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department to construct a new restroom and shelter facility at Century Park.
