

**A RESOLUTION ALLOWING TEMPORARY
DOWNTOWN SIDEWALK SALES AS PART OF
FIRST FRIDAY CELEBRATION**

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-7

WHEREAS, on the first Friday of each month, beginning in May 2018 and ending on September 2018, the Lebanon Downtown Association is sponsoring "First Friday" events to encourage residents and visitors to enjoy the City's downtown and to promote downtown businesses; and

WHEREAS, the downtown business community employs residents, supplies needed goods and services, provides important tax revenue for the City and is an important component in creating a strong, livable community; and

WHEREAS, it is important for citizens to recognize the importance and benefits of our downtown businesses and celebrate their role in making Lebanon a better place to live, work and play.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LEBANON, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Sidewalk Sales. Businesses located within the City's Central Business Commercial Zone may display merchandise on the City sidewalks as part of "First Friday". These sales may occur without the need of individual temporary use permits.

Section 2. Dates of Operation. The sidewalk sales are limited to the first Friday of the months May 2018 to September 2018.

Section 3. Display Conditions. The outdoor sales displays shall not interfere with pedestrian traffic along the sidewalks, or parking on City streets. A minimum 5-foot walkway along the sidewalk and in front of the business shall be maintained at all times.

Section 4. Hours of Operation. Outdoor sales displays shall begin no earlier than 10:00 am and end by 7:00 pm.

Section 5. Signs. Signs placed on sidewalks must conform to requirements in the Lebanon Development Code, Section 16.18.050.A.2.

Section 6. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon passage by the Council and approval of the Mayor.

Passed by the Lebanon City Council and executed by the Mayor on this 11th day of April, 2018 by a vote of 4 yeas and 0 nays.
