

RESOLUTION ELIMINATING STREET PARKING) RESOLUTION NO. 2019-20
ON MAIN AND PARK STREETS WITHIN THE)
CITY OF LEBANON)

WHEREAS, City Council being duly authorized by the Municipal Code to designate where traffic control devices shall be placed pursuant to LMC Chapter 10.16.060; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Lebanon as follows:


Section 1. Parking shall be eliminated along the west side of Park Street at the intersection of E Sherman Street, beginning at the southwest corner of Park and Sherman Streets, extending south approximately 20 feet. Parking shall also be eliminated along the east side of Main Street at the intersection of W Vine Street, beginning at the northeast corner of Main and Vine Streets, extending north approximately 20 feet.

Suitable signs shall be erected and/or markings painted and such designation shall be a part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon.

Section 2. This Resolution supersedes and replaces any conflicting portions of previous Resolutions governing parking at this location.


Passed by the Lebanon City Council and executed by the Mayor on this 10th day of July, 2019 by a vote of 4 yeas and 0 nays.
