Ordinance No. 621/2

An Ordinance providing for the building of cement side-walks, and making the building thereof obligatory along certain portions of the City of Lebanon, Linn Co, Oregon, and making the building thereof Voluntary and optional along certain portions of said City, and prohibiting the repairs to certain decaying walks along certain portions of said City.

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Sec. I.

That no wooden sidewalk shall be hereafter constructed on either side of Main Street between Ash Street on the North and Maple Street on the South;

All side-walks hereafter constructed on the aforesaid portions of Main Street shall be made with a foundation of rock, gravel and sand, properly mixed with good cement, and with an outside coating of sand and cement of standard grade and of usual thickness, so as to produce a smooth, even and durable surface, in accordance with the grade stakes of said street of the width of eight feet to the curbing of said street.

Sec. II.

No wooden sidewalk now constructed along said portion of Main Street shall be repaired unless the stringers supporting the portion thereof sought to be repaired are in such condition of soundness as to securely hold nails driven into said stringers.

Sec. III

- All such sidewalks, along said portion of Main Street, that are so decayed, as that the stringers supporting the surface boards will not securely hold nails when driven into said stringers, shall be removed and cement sidewalks built in their stead in accordance with Section One of this Ordinance, by the abutting property owners, (within thirty days from or after being notified by the City Marshal, by order of the City Council, in writing so to do.

Sec. IV

Cement sidewalks, to be built in accordance with Section One of this Ordinance, save as to width, may be constructed by the abutting property owners in lieu and in place of the wooden sidewalks now provided for by Ordinance, as follows:

- A walk six feet wide on either side of Main Street, between Ash Street and Rose Street;
- A walk four feet wide on either side of Main Street north of Rose Street;
- A walk eight feet wide on either side of Main Street south of Maple Street, and on either side of Sherman Street west of Main Street.

Sec. V

All parts of Ordinances so far as the same may conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Sec. VI

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from, on and after its approval by the Mayor.
