Ordinance No. 62

An Ordinance requiring all chimneys, flues and stove-pipes within the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, to be made to conform strictly to the Ordinances and Amendments thereto governing the same; and providing for the removal by the City Marshal of any chimney, flue or stove-pipe which does not conform strictly thereto; and providing for the punishment of persons not complying with the requirements of this Ordinance.

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows;

Sec. I.

That all chimneys, flues and stove-pipes, heretofore erected within the limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn Co., Oregon which do not conform strictly to all the requirements of the Ordinances and Amendments thereto of said City concerning the same, shall be made to conform strictly therewith, by the owners, occupants or agents of the owner of the premises upon which said chimneys, flues or stove-pipes are built, within ten days from the approval of this Ordinance by the Mayor.

Sec. II.

All chimneys, flues or stove-pipes, which have not been made to conform strictly to all the requirements of the Ordinances and Amendments thereto of said City concerning the same, within ten days from the approval of this Ordinance by the Mayor, shall be taken down and removed by the City Marshal.

Sec. III.

- All persons violating section one of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder's Court of said City, be fined not less than ten dollars or more than twenty five dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not less than five days or more than ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, at the Recorder's discretion.
