Ordinance No. 60

An Ordinance to amend Sections One and Five of Ordinance Number 10 of the City of Lebanon, Linne Co., Oregon, entitled "An Ordinance to provide for the prevention of fires and the protection of persons and property endangered by fire": and to provide greater protection against fire.

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Sect I

That Section One of the above entitled Ordinance Number ten is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sect I

That every chimney or flue which may be hereafter constructed in any frame building within said City shall have walls of good quality of brick or stone at least four inches in thickness of brick or stone securely laid in good lime mortar, and securely plastered therewith in the entire inside; and, also, likewise plastered on the outside when passing through or within one foot of any wood work or other combustible material. When any chimney or flue is not commenced on the ground, it shall rest upon a solid foundation of not less than four inches of brick or stone immediately above the support. No pallet chimney shall be used except those approved by the City Council in regular meeting and the description

of said patent chimneys entered of record in the proceedings of the City Council. No chimney or flue shall be constructed with any joist or timber resting on or entering or within one foot of said chimney or flue. All chimneys and flues shall be well secured, and shall extend, either with the same material or with galvanized iron smoke stacks or pipes, to a height not less than four feet above the highest point of any building, constructed of wood, within fifty feet of said chimney or flue. All chimney and flues and extensions thereof shall be protected with spark-catchers securely fastened to the highest point thereof. All openings for stove-pipes in chimneys or flues shall be protected by some non-combustible material extending at least eight inches on all sides of said openings in said chimneys or flues.

Sec. II

That Section Five of the above entitled Ordinance number Ten is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec V

It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit any ashes in any wooden vessel or any ^{wooden} ~~any~~ wooden surface or within ten feet of any combustible material. No person shall place any rubbish of combustible material within ten feet of any building constructed of wood. Every person, firm or corporation owning or occupying any frame building within said city shall remove from the roof thereof during the month of May in each year

~~Copied~~ all accumulations of moss and trash.

Sec. III

This Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from, onwards after its approval by the mayor.
