

An Ordinance providing for the election of City Marshal and Deputies by the City Council, defining their duties and qualifications, fixing their compensation, providing for their removal, and repealing such parts of other Ordinances as may be in conflict here with, of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows;

Sec. I.

At the first meeting of the City Council in January following a general City Election, <sup>annually</sup> there shall be selected by the Council a City Marshal to serve for one year, and until his successor is elected and qualified; and at said time, or whenever in the judgement of the City Council it may become necessary, the City Council shall appoint one or more deputies to serve during the pleasure of the City Council.

Sec. II.

The City Marshal and all Deputy Marshals shall be conservators of the peace within the City limits; report to the City Attorney and the City Council promptly all violations of the City Ordinances, make complaint and sign the same against all violators thereof, serve all warrants

subpoenas and other papers placed in his hands for service by the proper authority; attend all meetings of the City Council, and upon the Recorder's Court; Keep the City Jail and all other property of the City in proper condition; safely guard and attend to all City prisoners; build and repair all crosswalks; assist the City Attorney in the prosecution and defense of all cases in which the City is interested; and in addition thereto, the City Marshal and his Deputies shall do and perform all other duties, required of them by any ordinance and the Charter of the City, promptly and efficiently.

Sec III

The City Marshal and each Deputy Marshal shall be, at the time of his election or appointment, and shall so remain during his term of office, a legal voter of said City.

Sec IV

The City Marshal and any deputy Marshal may be removed from office at the pleasure of the City Council, upon a vote taken as provided by the City Charter and Ordinances, and without preferring charges.

Sec V

The City Marshal shall receive a monthly salary of forty Dollars, payable at the end of each month by a warrant drawn on the General Fund of said City, provided, however, that the City Council

may raise or lower said salary at its pleasure, by motion, resolution or ordinance. Deputy Marshals shall receive such compensations by the day, week, or month, as the City Council may from time to time fix, payable in the same manner

Sec VI

All parts of Ordinances that may not be in conflict herewith are hereby declared to be in force; and only such parts of ordinances as may be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec VII

This Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from, on and after its approval by the Mayor
