

Ordinance No. 66.

an ordinance to tax and license wood saws; defining what an wood saws, and to provide for the issuance of license to the owner or proprietor of wood saws, ^{and to punish any person operating a wood saw,} within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon Linn County Oregon, without first obtaining a license therefor, and to repeal Ordinance No. 38 of said City, passed by the City Council, over the Veto of the Mayor on the 16th day of April 1895.

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordains follows

Sec. 1.

The owner or proprietor of any wood saw, except those operated solely by hand, following the business of sawing wood within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon for hire, either as his sole occupation or in connection with other business, shall pay into the city Treasury the sum of Twenty Dollars annually to be computed from the date of the issuance of the license, in advance; Traction Engines engaging in the above occupation to pay Fifty (\$50) Dollars per year for license.

Sec. 2.

any person, firm or corporation, who, with the aid of a wood saw, run otherwise than by hand, shall saw or offer to saw, for hire, any wood or any material used for wood, within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, aforesaid, shall be deemed to be owner or proprietor of a wood saw, within the meaning of this Ordinance.

Sec. 3.

The owner or proprietor of any wood saw, within the meaning of this Ordinance, before engaging in the sawing of wood, or any material used for wood, for hire, within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, aforesaid, shall take out a license therefor in accordance with the ordinance of the said City governing the issuance of license.

Sec. 4.

The owner or proprietor of any wood saw, within the meaning of this ordinance, who shall hereafter saw or offer to saw any wood or any material used for wood, for hire within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, aforesaid, without first obtaining a license therefor, as provided for by this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court, be fined not less than ten dollars, nor more than fifty dollars, or be imprisoned in the City Jail not less than five days nor more than twenty five days.

Sec. 5:

Ordinance No. 38. of the City of Lebanon, aforesaid, passed by the City Council over the veto of the Mayor on the 16th day of April 1895 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 6.

This Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from on and after its approval by the Mayor.
