

Ordinance No. 68.

An Ordinance prohibiting any person from being intoxicated upon any street, alley or public place within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and providing for the punishment of such person.

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1.

That it shall be unlawful for any person to be intoxicated upon any street or alley or in any public place within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than Ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, or be imprisoned in the City Jail, not less than five days nor more than fifty days.

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect, from and after its approval by the Mayor.
