Ordinance No. 70.

An ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 67 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

Passed by the City Council October 2nd 1907 and approved by the Mayor on the 2nd day of October, 1906. Entitled, "an ordinance to Tax and License Billiard Tables, Pool Tables and Combination Billiard-Pool Tables, and Ocean Wares: To provide for issuing License therefor; and to prohibit and punish any violation of this Ordinance in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1.

That Ordinance No. 67 of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, passed by the Council on the 2nd day of October, 1906. and approved by the Mayor on the 2nd day of October, 1906. And entitled, "An ordinance to Tax and License, Billiard Tables, Pool Tables, Combination Billiard-pool Tables, and Ocean Wares: To provide for issuing License therefor; and to prohibit and punish any violation of this Ordinance in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon. be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from 30 days after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
