An Ordinance to provide for the material to be used in and the manner of construction and the width of side walks on the south side of Sherman Street and the North Side of Grant Street between Main Street and Third Street in the City of Lebanon in County, Oregon. And to repeal all Ordinances or part thereof in conflict with this Ordinance.

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1

That all side walks hereafter made in the City of Lebanon, in County, Oregon, on the South side of Sherman Street between Main Street and Third Street shall be made of Sand, Gravel and Cement in the manner and in the proportion as required and prescribed by the Charter and the Ordinance of the said City, and said side walks shall be Eight feet wide and put on the Grade.

Section 2

That all side walks now built or upon the said South side of said Sherman Street between said Main Street and Third Street which are less than Eight feet wide shall be widened to eight feet, and no part of any walk shall be of other material than Sand, gravel and Cement place on grade and in the manner and in the proportions as required and prescribed by the Charter and Ordinance of said City.

Section 3

That all side walks hereafter made and placed on the North side of Grant Street and between Main Street and Third Street shall be Eight feet wide and built of either Cement or wood and shall be placed on the grade and shall be laid and built in the manner and of the material and of the dimension as by

the Charter and the Ordinance of the said City required and prescribed.

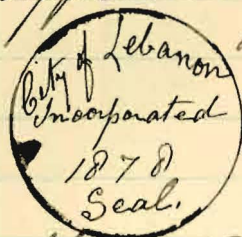
Section 4

That all Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5

That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after Thirty days from its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

An Ordinance to amend Section 37 of an Ordinance numbered 33 of the City of Lebanon, Entitled an Ordinance concerning offenses and disorderly conduct defining what shall constitute the same and provided for the punishment thereof and to repeal Ordinance No 3.
The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows.

Section 1

That section 37 of Ordinance 33 be amended so as to read as follows: Section 37: it is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person or persons to cast, throw or deposit, or suffer, permit or allow to be cast, thrown or deposited in or upon any street, alley or any public place within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, any manure filth or offal of any kind whatsoever, except dust or snow which may have accumulated upon the sidewalks, and any person or persons
