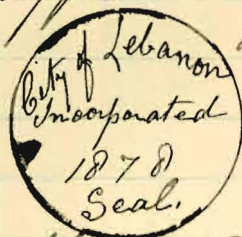

which

An Ordinance to amend Section 37 of an Ordinance numbered 33 of the City of Lebanon, Entitled an Ordinance concerning offenses and disorderly conduct defining what shall constitute the same and provided for the punishment thereof and to repeal Ordinance No 3.
The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows.

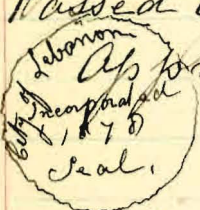
Section 1

That section 37 of Ordinance 33 be amended so as to read as follows: Section 37: it is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person or persons to cast, throw or deposit, or suffer, permit or allow to be cast, thrown or deposited in or upon any street, alley or any public place within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, any manure filth or offal of any kind whatsoever, except dust or snow which may have accumulated upon the sidewalks, and any person or persons

violating any of these provisions hereof or of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court be punished by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars or more than fifty Dollars or by imprisonment in the City jail not less than five days or more than twenty five days.

Section 2 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after thirty days from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

An Ordinance to licence Regulate and Restrain Moving Picture Shows or Shows Throwing Pictures on Canvass or Simila Devices, and To Define what shall constitute The Same.

The People of Lebanon do Ordain as follows:

Section 1 All moving picture shows, or shows given by throwing pictures on canvass or other devices and usually called or known as moving picture show shall pay a license fee of \$2⁰⁰ a day or \$10⁰⁰ a quarter in advance. And no performance shall be given by any such show untill the manager or agent of the same shall have first procured from the City Recorder a license therefor and shall have paid to the City Treasurer the fees as herein required.

Section 2 No licence shall be issued or granted for any show that in the judgment of the Council is immoral, obscene or improper for a public exhibition. If any
