Ordinance Bill No. 83

Ordinance No. 79-

An Ordinance to license and regulate Peddling and Hawking within the Corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, and define what shall constitute the same, and to repeal all Ordinances in conflict herewith and to provide for the punishment of any violation of this Ordinance.

The People of Lebanon do Ordains as follows:

Section 1. Any peddler or hawker, who shall conduct his business within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, shall pay a license therefor as follows: when traveling with two or more animals Five Dollars a day, or Fifty Dollars a quarter; when traveling with one animal Four Dollars per day, or Forty Dollars per quarter; when traveling on foot \$2 1/2 per day or \$30.00 per quarter. All persons, except persons peddling newspapers Bibles and religious tracts and persons peddling the products of their own farms, gardens, or Milk ranches who sell or offer for sale at retail goods, wares merchandise, or other commodities traveling from place to place and from house to house within the city limits shall be deemed a peddler or hawker under this Ordinance.

Section 2 That any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, or peddling or offering to peddle or hawk within the corporate limits of Lebanon, without first taking out or procuring and paying for the license as herein provided shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court for the said City of Lebanon, shall be punished by a fine

of not less than \$10⁰⁰ nor more than \$100⁰⁰
or by imprisonment in the City Jail of not less
than five days ~~or~~ nor more than fifty days.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict
herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after thirty days after its
passage by the Council and approval
by the Mayor.

An Ordinance to establish a Curb Line
and Curb grade for the City of Lebanon,
and to establish the depth of the Street
line below the top of curb, and to provide
the manner and material for the
construction of curbs.

The people of the City of Lebanon, do Ordain
as follows:

Section 1. All Curbs hereafter made in the city
of Lebanon of whatever material shall be
constructed out eight ft from the
adjacent lot line, and the top of the curb
shall be on a line with the street grade,
and shall also be on a line with the
sidewalk grade,
