## Ordinance No 83

Introduced by Ordinance Committee,  
An Ordinance to prevent the keeping of Hogs  
within the City Limits of the City of Lebanon,  
Linn County, Oregon, and to provide for the  
punishment of any violation of this Ordinance  
and to define what shall constitute such  
keeping of Hogs.

The People of the City of Lebanon do Ordain as follows:

Section 1

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons  
firm or corporation to keep or permit to be kept  
within the city limits of the city of Lebanon  
any Hog or Hogs, for feeding, fattening, growing  
or other purposes.

Section 2

The Keeping of Hogs within the City limits  
for shipping for a period longer than 48 hours  
shall be deemed a violation of this Ordinance,  
without a written permit from the Mayor or  
committee on health and Police.

Section 3

All persons firms or corporations who now  
have or keep any Hog or Hogs within the city  
limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon,  
shall cease to so keep the same within the  
city limits after 60 days from the passage  
of this Ordinance and its approval by  
the Mayor.

Section 4

Any person, firm or corporation violating  
any of the provisions of this Ordinance  
shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and  
upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court  
shall be punished by a fine not less  
than Ten Dollars or more than \$100<sup>00</sup>  
or by imprisonment not less than

Five days nor more than 50 days in  
the City Jail.

Ordinance Bill No 88

Ordinance No 84

Introduced by committee on Health and Police.

An Ordinance To Provide For The Manner of  
Construction of Cesspools and Privies and to  
Provide for the depth and size of same and  
to prevent the same from becoming filthy  
or a nuisance and to provide for the cleaning  
of Back yards, lots, and alleys within the  
City of Lebanon, and to provide for the  
punishment of any violation of this Ordinance.

The People of the City of Lebanon do Ordain as follows.

Section 1:

That all Cesspools and privies Holes hereafter  
made in the City of Lebanon shall be not  
less than two feet wide and three feet long  
and shall not be less than 4 feet deep  
and in all cases shall be dug down to gravel  
in order to give subdrainage, where gravel  
is within 6 feet of top of Soil.

Section 2:

All cesspools and Privies Holes now existing  
or being in the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
