and all hereafter made shall be cleaned out sufficiently frequent so as to prevent the varne home becoming tilthy, or annoying to any resident living in the vicinity of the same, or to become dangerous to the public health.

Section 3: I All Alleys lots and Back yards shall be kept in a clean condition and no rubbish or decaying matter shall be left or permitted to be be remain in any back yard lot or alley in the said bits.

Section 4: It shall be the duty of the bity Marshall and bity Health Officer & see that the provisions of this ordinance are complied with.

When in The opinion of the bity Health Officer any cess pool Privy or alley lot or back yard is in such condition as to endanger the public health of the buty or is in a felthy condition, he shall give written notice & the person or personal maintaining the same, or the owner or occupant of the premises on which the same exerts, to clean out the said cesspool or & clean up The said premises and to abake and descontinue the said filthy condition of such premeses, within such time above reasonable to comply with the said notice and order The sould Health Officer shall file a complaint with The Cuty Hecorder charging such person or persons with maintianing and permitting such news ance or condition, and thereup on a warrant of arrest shall be issued by the Said Meleorder and The person or persons Therein described whall be brought before The losty Meconder for trial, and if ofter a trial it be foundly the bout that the person or persons charged are quilts of permitting or maintaining such eets pools, alleys or lot

or back yard or any or either of them in a fithy or unhealthy condition such person or person's shall be deerned quilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$ 10000, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding \$ 0 days.

any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed quilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction therefor before the Accorded bourt shall be punished by a fine not exceeding to days in the buty Jail,
