Ordinance Bill No 88

Ordinance No 84

Introduced by committee on Health and Police.

An Ordinance To Provide For The Manner of  
Construction of Cesspools and Privies and to  
Provide for the depth and size of same and  
to prevent the same from becoming filthy  
or a nuisance and to provide for the cleaning  
of Back yards, lots, and alleys within the  
City of Lebanon, and to provide for the  
punishment of any violation of this Ordinance.

The People of the City of Lebanon do Ordain as follows.

Section 1:

That all Cesspools and privies Holes hereafter  
made in the City of Lebanon shall be not  
less than two feet wide and three feet long  
and shall not be less than 4 feet deep  
and in all cases shall be dug down to gravel  
in order to give subdrainage, where gravel  
is within 6 feet of top of Soil.

Section 2:

All cesspools and Privies Holes now existing  
or being in the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

and all hereafter made shall be cleaned out sufficiently frequent so as to prevent the same from becoming filthy, or annoying to any resident living in the vicinity of the same, or to become dangerous to the public health.

Section 3:

All Alleys lots and Back yards shall be kept in a clean condition and no rubbish or decaying matter shall be left or permitted to be or remain in any back yard lot or alley in the said City.

Section 4:

It shall be the duty of the City Marshall and City Health Officer to see that the provisions of this Ordinance are complied with.

Section 5:

When in the opinion of the City Health Officer any cess pool Privy or alley lot or back yard is in such condition as to endanger the public health of the City, or is in a filthy condition, he shall give written notice to the person or persons maintaining the same, or to the owner or occupant of the premises on which the same exists, to clean out the said cesspool or to clean up the said premises and to abate and discontinue the said filthy condition of such premises, within such time as are reasonable, and upon <sup>the</sup> failure of such person or persons to comply with the said notice and order the said Health Officer shall file a complaint with the City Recorder charging such person or persons with maintaining and permitting such nuisance or condition, and thereupon a warrant of arrest shall be issued by the said Recorder and the person or persons therein described shall be brought before the City Recorder for trial, and if after a trial it be found by the Court that the person or persons charged are guilty of permitting or maintaining such cess pools, Alleys or lot

or back yard or any or either of them in a filthy or unhealthy condition such person or persons shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100<sup>00</sup>, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding 50 days.

Section 6i-

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction therefor before the Recorder's Court shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100<sup>00</sup>, or by imprisonment not exceeding 30 days in the City Jail.
