Ordinance Bill No. 90  
Ordinance No 86

An Ordinance To Define What Shall  
Constitute a Legally Constructed  
Side Walk within the City of Lebanon,  
Linn County, Oregon. And to punish  
for any Injury or Damage to such  
walks and to prevent Riding or  
Driving on the same.

The People of the City of Lebanon do ordain  
as follows:-

Section 1 All side walks within the City of Lebanon,  
Linn County, Oregon, made heretofore, or  
hereafter made and constructed in the  
manner herein provided shall be deemed  
legally made and constructed sidewalks  
to wit:- 1- All wooden sidewalks made and  
constructed with decking and stringers  
in the manner now provided by Ordinance  
and by such ordinances as may hereafter be  
duly enacted on that subject. 2 - All Cement  
side walks made and constructed in the  
manner and of the material now provided  
for the construction of Cement sidewalks and  
in such manner as may hereafter provided  
for the construction of such walks. 3 -  
All decomposed granite sidewalks heretofore  
or hereafter made by the authority of the  
common council of the City of Lebanon, and  
in such localities and places as may be  
permitted by the said council by permission  
therefor first had and obtained from the said  
council; provided all sidewalks so made of  
decomposed granite or crushed granite shall  
be placed on grade as established by the  
Council, and shall be laid with a foundation  
of gravel with a thorough top coating of decomposed  
granite or crushed granite well tamped and  
Packed.

Section 2. Decomposed granite walks shall only be built in such places and in such localities in the said City as shall be permitted by the common council, and any person desiring to construct such side walk shall first make application to the said Council and if the Council shall deem it for the best interest to the said City to permit such walk in such locality the permit shall be granted. All applications for any decomposed granite sidewalk or crushed granite sidewalk shall specify with convenient certainty the location of the said proposed walk.

Section 3

Any person who shall suffer or permit to go upon, or shall lead, drive or ride any horse, mule, or other animal, or any cattle or other stock, the property of, or in the possession of or under the control of such person, upon any sidewalk herein described within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Lin County, Oregon, or shall drive any wagon or vehicle upon or across any such walk, or violate any provision of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be punished by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars nor more than Fifty Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not more than five days nor more than twenty five days.

Section 4

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after Thirty days from its passage by the common Council and approval by the Mayor.
