Ordinance Bill No 99
Ordinance No 95-

An Ordinance to fix the compensation of certain Officers of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

Section 1 - The people of City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

The Marshal of the City of Lebanon shall receive a salary of \$65.00 a month to be paid monthly as other Bills against the City are paid which said sum shall be in full for all services to the City of Lebanon by him as such officer, and in addition to the duties as a police officer he shall do such other duties as by ordinance provided and ordered by the Council.

Section 2

The Recorder of the City of Lebanon shall receive a salary of \$100.00 a year to be paid quarterly as other bills against the city are paid, which said sum shall be in full for all services rendered the said City by him as such officer, whether as Clerk of the Council, Police Judge or for issuing licenses or other clerical work in connection with the said office. All fees and fines collected by the said Recorder shall be turned over to the City Treasurer as now provided by law, and he shall make and file a report each quarter of all moneys collected by him as now provided by law, or ordinance.

Section 3

The Treasurer of the City of Lebanon shall receive a salary of \$75.00 a year which shall be paid quarterly as other Bills against the City are paid, which said sum shall be in full for all services rendered the said City by the said officer.

Section 4

The City Attorney for the City of Lebanon shall receive a salary of \$120.00 a year, which said sum shall be in full for all general

services rendered for ^{the} said City as counsel for the City officers and for prosecuting all cases in the City Courts, Provided however that the Council may allow such other sums as are reasonable for extraordinary services, or for litigation in state or other outside Courts. The salary and compensation of the said Attorney shall be allowed and paid as other Bills against the City are paid.

Section 5

The Health Officer of the City of Lebanon shall be paid a salary of \$10.00 a year for his services as such officer and shall also receive the sum of \$1.50 for each necessary visit made to any sick person who is under the care or treatment of the City.

Section 6

All the officers of the said City whose salaries are provided for herein shall perform all the duties now provided by Ordinance for such officers, or that may be hereafter provided for them to perform by the common Council of the said City, and they shall not receive directly or indirectly any other fees or compensation from the said City for any work or services than that herein provided, for services as such officers

Section 7

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the first Monday in January, 1910.
