

Ordinance Bill No 96  
Ordinance No 92

An Ordinance to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No 71 entitled "an Ordinance to tax, license and regulate Billiard tables, Pool tables, and combination Billiard-Pool tables, providing for the time when the places were same are used shall be closed, and to prevent the playing of cards or card games in Billiard and Pool rooms and other places and to prevent minors women and girls being in Pool and Billiard rooms and to punish any violation of this Ordinance" Passed by the Council of the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1907, and approved by the Mayor of the said City on 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1907.

The People of the City of Lebanon do Ordain as follows:

Section 1

That Section 1 of said Ordinance 71 be and the same is amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1

That the owner, proprietor, or keeper of any Billiard table, Pool table or combination billiard-pool table, in the city of Lebanon, for profit or for which a charge is made or exacted for the playing on any games thereon, shall pay a license therefor as follows: \$30.00 a year for one table, \$50.00 a year for two tables, and \$60.00 for three tables, and \$20.00 a year for each additional table, and that no license shall be taken out for a longer period than one year or less period than six months. All six months license shall be half the annual license. In addition to the license hereby provided for the applicant shall pay to the Recorder the sum of \$1.00 for issuing every <sup>such</sup> license, which shall be in full for all his services, in connection with the issuing

the same. Before any such tables are used in the said City the said proprietor owner or keeper shall procure from the Recorder such license and pay to the City Treasurer the fees herein required in the manner prescribed by ordinance of the said City for procuring licenses.

Passed by the Council this 21 day of Sept 1909.
