An Ordinance to regulate the manner and place of setting Electric Light Poles, Telephone Poles or other Poles set in the streets and alleys of the City of Lebanon, and to provide for the Punishment for any violation of this Ordinance.

The People of the City of Lebanon do Ordains as follows:

Section 1. All Electric Light Poles hereafter set in any street in the City of Lebanon, and any Telephone Poles, Electric Street Car Poles and all other poles for wires set in the streets of the said City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon. shall be so set that the center line of the Pole shall be Nine feet in the street from the lot line, and all wires for any one service shall be of uniform height on the same side of any street. Provided that at railroad crossing of street car crossing on any street the wires and poles may be at such height as convenient for the traffic of such lines.

Section 2. No poles shall be introduced by any front of the door or entrance of any business house or dwelling in the said City without the consent of both the owner or occupant of the said building.

Section 3. Before any person, person, firm, company, association or corporation shall set any poles for the purpose of stringing wires thereon for any purpose in any of the streets, or alleys of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, application shall be made to the superintendent of streets for the said city for a permit to set such poles, which application shall state the location, and street on which the same is proposed to be set, and it shall be the duty of the said street superintendent to grant a permission to set such poles in the manner as by ordinances permitted.

It shall be the duty of the Superintendent of streets to see that all poles set in the said City are placed as in this ordinance provided.

Section 4 If any person, or persons, company, association or corporation shall set any poles in any streets or alley of the City of Lebanon, without first applying for and obtaining the permission as hereby required, or shall set any pole or poles other than as herein permitted and required or shall do any other act or acts in violation of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefor before the Recorder's Court shall be punished by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars not more than \$50.00 or by imprisonment in the City jail not less than five days nor more than 25 days.

Section 5

That in as much as many poles are now being set in the said City and the City has no law regulating the same, and that the safety of the city from fires requires the regulation of the setting of such poles it is necessary that this ordinance become effective at once, an emergency is therefore declared and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
