

Ordinance Bill No 102

Ordinance No 98

An Ordinance to regulate the use of the Streets for the purpose of moving buildings and structures therein  
the people of Lebanon do ordain as follows

Section

1 That no person or persons firm company or Corporation shall use any portion of any Streets or alley in the city of Lebanon for the removal of any building structure or edifice without first obtaining a permit therefor as herein provided

Section

2 Application for permit shall be in writing and shall specify the kind of building structure or edifice to be removed and shall state the number of the lot and block upon which it stands or is situated the size of the building and the number of the lot and block to which it is proposed to be moved the row and streets to be taken and the probable length of time required for such removal

Section

3 Permits shall be signed and issued by the Superintendent of Streets upon the recommendation of the Committee on Streets and public property of the Common Council of the city of Lebanon which recommendation shall be endorsed on the application the application shall be filed in the office of the Recorder of the said city and the said Recorder shall keep in a convenient manner the dates description of the Property and the objects for which the permit is granted

Section

4 the said Committee on Streets and public property shall also endorse upon the said application the row and streets for such removal and the date upon which such permit will expire together with such restrictions as the public

interest and safety may require the committee may in their discretion require security to be given by deposit or otherwise by the applicant for any damage that may occur by carelessness neglect or failure to comply with the provisions of this ordinance

Section

5-

The removal of a building structure or edifice under a permit when commenced shall continue during the work hours of the day, and day by day until completed with the least possible obstruction to the thoroughfare and streets occupied no building structure or edifice being moved shall remain over night upon any street crossing or intersection or so near any fire hydrant as to prevent or interfere with easy access thereto signal lights shall be conspicuously placed at each end of such building structure or edifice being moved during the time the streets lights are burned by the city

Section

6

Upon the completion of the moving of the said building structure or edifice or the expiration of the time named in the said permit the street shall be by and at the expense of the person or persons to whom the permit was granted cleaned of all rubbish and obstruction and placed in as good condition and repair as it was before the permit was granted

Section

7

any person or person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the recorder's Court shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars or by imprisonment in the city jail for not less than two days nor more than twenty five days

each day of maintaining or continuing such violation shall be deemed a separate offence and punished accordingly

Section

8

in as much as the city of Lebanon has no law on the subject of moving buildings in the streets of the said city and the promiscuous moving of such is a menace to the safety of the said city and endangers life and property an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor
